Healing Scriptures

(all Scripture is from the King James translation unless otherwise indicated)

- Ps 103:2-3 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;
- Ex 15:26 ... I am the LORD that healeth thee.
- Is 53: 4-5 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
- Is 53:4-5 Surely He has borne our griefs (sicknesses, weaknesses, and distresses) and carried our sorrows *and* pains [of punishment], yet we [ignorantly] considered Him stricken, smitten, and afflicted by God [as if with leprosy]. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our guilt *and* iniquities; the chastisement [needful to obtain] peace *and* well-being for us was upon Him, and with the stripes [that wounded] Him we are healed *and* made whole. (Amplified Bible)
- 1 Peter 2:24 ...by whose stripes ye were healed.
- James 5:16 Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.
- Psalm 30:2 O LORD my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me.
- Psalm 77:14 Thou art the God that doest wonders: thou hast declared thy strength among the people.
- Psalm 107:20 He sent his word, and healed them...
- Php 4:19 But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.
- Joel 3:10 ...let the weak say, I am strong.
- Prov. 3:5-8 Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

 Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.

 It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.

- Pr 4: 20-23 My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings.

 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart.

 For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.

 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.
- Mk 9:23 "...all things are possible to him that believeth." (Jesus speaking)
- 1Jn 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.
- Mk 16:17-18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Mk 11:22-24 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.
- 1 Jn 5:14-15 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.
- Mt 8:2-3 And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.
- Mt 8:16-17 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: That it be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.
- II Cor 4:13 ...according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak;
- Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.
- Jer 33:6 ... I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and truth.
- Jer 30:17 For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD;

- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- 1 John 4:4 ... greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:
- Ps 118:16-17 The right hand of the LORD is exalted: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly. I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD.

Notes:

It is God's will to heal. There are many instances in the Gospels where Jesus healed all who were sick. Illness is not from God. Jesus healed countless sick people. If their illnesses were from God, he would have been working against himself. Illness is the result of a fallen world. Jesus Christ earned our healing by his actions in going to the cross. Healing is another benefit of the atonement. People have to receive the healing that has already been earned, just as they have to receive forgiveness of sin that has already been earned by Christ and is available through God's grace to all people (even with salvation, people still have to receive – acknowledge who Jesus is, give their life to Christ, repent).

Praise: Praise of God and reading Scripture are good preparatory steps to receiving healing.

- Ps 95:1-2 O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms.
- Ps 34:1 I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth
- Ps 100:4 Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.
- Joel 2:21 Fear not, O land; be glad and rejoice: for the LORD will do great things.
- Luke 24:53 And were continually in the temple, praising and blessing God.
- Ps 150:6 Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD.
- Ps 117 O praise the LORD, all ye nations: praise him, all ye people. For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the truth of the LORD endureth for ever. Praise ye the LORD.
