- Rise in lawlessness
- Everyone rushing to and fro
- Breakdown of family unit
- Time compression
- Mass communication
- God pouring out his spirit
- Hebrew back as language of Israel
- Shekel back in use in Israel

Seeking to be very clear about his return, Jesus made the point that as it was in the days of Noah so it shall be at his returning. Similarly, he referred to the days of Lot. What did he mean? In the days of Noah, in Jesus own words, people were eating, drinking, marrying, and being given in marriage up to the day Noah entered the ark and the flood came. As regards the days of Lot, people were eating and drinking, buying and selling, planting and building, but when Lot left the city, fire and sulfur rained down from heaven and destroyed them all. In other words, people continued to live oblivious of all that was about to happen. Our world is full of people like that. [One other characteristic of the days of Lot was blatant homosexual behavior (Genesis 19), another characteristic shared by today's world.].

It is a remnant that goes with Jesus when he comes and calls his elect, his people, his sheep. How many? He knows. Not us. Not our assignment. The relationship between a person and God is between that person and God. No one else can save a person but Jesus, not a spouse, a parent, or a child. No one. People who know Jesus know they know Jesus. People who don't know Jesus don't know they don't know. People who hear God speak know they hear him speak. People who never have don't think it possible. All that said, we surely can pray for the Father to lead lost people to Jesus. After all, Jesus said no one can come to him unless his father draws that person to him.


