NOW IT ALL COMES ABOUT

Certain scriptures from throughout the Bible are suddenly and clearly relating directly to what is happening on earth now. I'm speaking of scriptures other than the prophecy ones we have been looking at as regards the return of Jesus. There is just so much in the Bible that applies to our time right now that I want to share some and then follow with a specific critical update of the timetable of events to happen.

Let's look at some of these scriptures:

- Jesus' primary warning of our day is not to be deceived. Deception, lying, is a hallmark of many in our day. His warning is given in Matthew 24:4: "Watch out that no one deceives you. (That is also stated in Luke 21:8 and Mark 13:5).
- Another couple of powerful scriptures note that eventually God turns those who live a habitually ungodly lifestyle, who refuse to accept the truth, over to a spirit of delusion. They are given a reprobate mind. They are done for. They are lost. Using another word from scripture, they are perishing. I referred to this once as people perishing in our midst. You can read about all this in Romans 1:18-32 and 2 Thessalonians 2:9-12.
- Then there is Psalm 2 which you may not have recognized applies to today until now:

Why do the nations conspire, and the peoples plot in vain? ² The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the Lord and his anointed, saying, ³ "Let us burst their bonds asunder, and cast their cords from us." ⁴ He who sits in the heavens laughs; the Lord has them in derision.

I especially like verse 4. God holds those who do such things in derision. I do hope you have noted the groups acting out so badly in the USA are not alone in the world. In many nations throughout Europe and in Brazil and in other places, some leaders and groups work tirelessly towards the one world government, tirelessly towards controlling the people. In several countries now those in power have used their judiciaries to keep popular opposition from even being able to run in elections, a bit like what we have seen in the US in recent years. In France for example, the leader of the conservative party was just found guilty of some crime that keeps her from running in the next election.

And then there is this dramatic scripture I have been pointing out more and more:

²There is nothing concealed that will not be disclosed, or hidden that will not be made known. ³What you have said in the dark will be heard in the daylight, and what you have whispered in the ear in the inner rooms will be proclaimed from the roofs. – Luke 12

We all see this happening rapidly now in front of our eyes! Here are just three examples:

- Papers long held in secret by the government are being turned over to the public, papers about the JFK, RFK, and MLK assassinations.
- The current US Department of Government Efficiency is discovering enormous corruption in many areas of the federal government, with massive sums having disappeared or having been given to others for no obvious good reason. We wonder if there will be any accountability for those involved in such actions on earth (surely ultimately they will face judgement, God's judgement.)
- Actions of government in recent years that have greatly harmed the US are being brought into
 the light, such as giving millions of illegal aliens social security cards and thus opening the way
 for these noncitizens to receive all sorts of benefits and to even eventually vote in elections.
- Then there is this dramatic and chilling scripture from 2 Timothy 3 about the behavior of people in our day:

But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days. ² People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, ³ without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good, ⁴ treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God— ⁵ having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with such people.

And there is the painful prophecy from Jesus in Matthew 10:35-36 where Jesus notes his coming causes
family members to rebel against each other, all this of course being unbelievers against believers. You
may have already experienced some form of this or know someone who has.

All this I cite just to show how so many areas of scripture other than the usual prophecy ones we talk about regarding the last days are now coming to fruition.

UPDATED TIMELINE FOR THESE LAST DAYS

We all need an updated very specific timeline of events soon to happen, for ourselves and to share.

The first and primary point of the timeline is just this: Anytime from right now to sometime in the near future, Jesus will return to collect all believers living and those believers who have died. We do not know that specific hour or day but the operative word is "soon." There is nothing that must happen before he does this.

It must happen so the next step can occur and the Tribulation can begin. Wonderfully, all believers collected by Jesus will receive their new glorious bodies as part of this collection process. And then this all ensues:

- With believers gone from the earth, the Antichrist is no longer held back and is free to go forward with his work. Who has been holding him back? Believers and the Holy Spirit acting through them. – 2 Thessalonians 2:3-8
- This Antichrist leads and brings about the signing of an agreement with the Jews, with Israel, which they
 apparently truly believe brings peace. Daniel 9:27
- The Tribulation begins when this agreement is confirmed, signed. Daniel 9:27.
- Now, we believers are in new glorious bodies in Heaven with Jesus throughout the Tribulation period (Please note that we do not know much about what will be happening during this Tribulation period with the believers who Jesus has taken to Heaven. Little is said about this, other than that we will be attending the marriage supper of the Lamb and that we will be returning with Jesus when he comes to fight the battle at Armageddon as noted below. Also obviously from what we see in Revelation, there will be times of singing and praising God and the Lord!) See 1 Corinthians 15:51-53, Revelation 19:9, 11-21
- On earth, many things happen during these seven years, including these:
 - Antichrist and his assistant the false prophet work to put together the new one world government
 - Image of antichrist is built by false prophet. Revelation 13:14
 - People are expected to worship this image. Revelation 13:15
 - Antichrist government requires people to have mark on forehead or right hand in order to participate in commercial marketplace (e.g., to buy and sell) – Revelation 13:16-17
 - Those testifying for Jesus and the Word of God and not accepting the mark or not worshipping the beast are killed (maybe some rebel and hide out and survive – this we do not know) – Revelation 20:4
 - Some come to accept Jesus as Lord during this period and are known as Tribulation saints. They
 are noted in the book of Revelation. Likely they are killed but again possibly some hide out and
 survive. Revelation 7:14
 - Midway through the Tribulation the Antichrist sets up an abomination in the temple in Jerusalem, which will have been built. – Daniel 9:27
 - Two men obviously sent by God appear in Jerusalem and begin preaching the gospel message.
 No one can stop them. Perhaps these two are Moses and Elijah as many think, but this is not actually known. Revelation 11:3
 - After 3 and ½ years, these two somehow are killed. The people in Jerusalem celebrate and give gifts. - Revelation 11:7-10
 - But after just a few days, these two witnesses rise from the dead. A voice from Heaven says
 "come up here" and they do. Revelation 7:11-12
 - At the end of the Tribulation a giant battle is held at Armageddon near Jerusalem. Jesus on a
 white horse leads an army of the holy ones the angels and his believers down to the battle
 against the forces of the Antichrist. Revelation 19:11-18

- In the battle Jesus himself by the sword in his mouth kills all those soldiers there to fight against him. The false prophet and the antichrist are thrown into the Lake of Fire. An angel comes down and throws the devil into a deep pit and locks him there for a thousand years. - Revelation 19:19-21; 20:1-3
- The Kingdom of God government is actually, physically established under Jesus in Jerusalem. Jesus' believers in their glorious bodies help him rule for a thousand years. Revelation 20:4-6
- At the end of the thousand years a final white throne judgement is held. The dead rise and unbelievers are thrown into the lake of fire (which I assume is all those who had died in the past and had not been believers, and those unbelievers who have died during the thousand years). Revelation 20:11-15
- A New Jerusalem comes down from Heaven, a new giant city in which God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ reside. There is no need for light, for they are the light. There is never any darkness. Believers live in the city. No one else is allowed in. The city is described as a huge cube about 1,400 miles on each edge with walls about 200 feet thick. Revelation 21

As you can see, much is to happen on earth during the seven year Tribulation. But believers in the Lord will not be there. Again as noted above, Jesus comes anytime now to collect his believers and take them with him. In fact, I point out again the Tribulation cannot begin until he does this, for the antichrist cannot be released to go about his work until believers are taken out of the way. Once released he can work towards getting that agreement with the Jews signed and the Tribulation will begin.

The thousand year millennium that follows the Tribulation surely seems an interesting period, with the world no doubt rebuilt to handle all the destruction of the Tribulation and with believers in their glorious bodies working in the Kingdom of God government on earth. Jesus has said we will rule with him, and this is that. During the thousand years normal people will live I suppose normal lives although we are told that they will live a long time, that a person who dies at a hundred will be thought to have died young. Many questions remain unanswered, such as what happens to these normal people when they become believers. We will just have to wait and see.
