REMEMBER GOD'S GREAT TOOLS AND GIFTS FOR HIS BELIEVERS – VITAL IN THESE DAYS

In these trying last days, we all need to remember to live and operate in the great truths and promises of God, using the tools and gifts he has given us!!! These are trying times but God well provides for his believers!

- Remember especially the gifts/tools of protection that God has given believers. We have written much about this in recent years. (Read our June 2024 newsletter which covers all this in detail.). These protection gifts/tools are in three categories:
 - Paul wrote about the first category, the armor God has for us. Read all about this in Ephesians 6:10-18. I suggest you put this armor on the beginning of every day. The newsletter above explains how to do that.
 - In Hebrews 1:13 we find another gift of protection. Here we see that God has sent angels to serve us, his believers. So wherever you are they are there. Service surely includes protection.
 - Jesus gave his believers the authority to cast out evil. Wherever you are, when you leave a group you can say "In Jesus name, I order all evil spirits to get away from me." I recommend doing that at the end and beginning of every day. Before visiting in a hospital and after leaving there I always order away all evil spirits and add such things as harmful germs, bacteria, virus, and more. There is a reason people are in the hospital.
- Remember that by Jesus stripes you have been healed! You all know the many healing scriptures I have often quoted and applied over the years. Now of all times we need our health! To refresh yourself on all this go to the healing resource page on our website where you can print out such scriptures and get other information, watch our many healing videos on our website, and read the August 2021, March 2020, and February 2017 newsletters in the newsletter archives there. Basically in going to the cross and his death and resurrection, he took upon himself all our sicknesses, diseases, and pain and overcame them by his stripes we have been healed (just as he overcame our sins and evil and death and curses of the law and so much more).

- God provides all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.
- In Mark 11:22-24 Jesus explains how a believer can cast the mountain in their life into the sea. And if the believer stands firm in his faith, in his belief, and does not doubt, it will be done as he has said. For instance, order the mountain of your debt to throw itself into the sea and be gone! This may happen immediately, but if not stand firm on this promise and declare it every day.
- Believers can do the same thing Jesus did. Who said that? He did, in John 14. We can do even more according to the Lord. I think believers on earth today do not begin to operate in the authority they have, in the power of the gospel.
- Gifts of the Spirit These are marvelous wonder-working gifts that those filled with and baptized in the Spirit have, from the gift of healings to the gift of miraculous works, the gift of speaking in tongues, the gift of discernment that is so incredibly valuable in this day of massive deception, the gift of prophecy, and more. The Spirit-led believer who has these gifts has a tremendous advantage in this world. He discerns truth from falsehood that others cannot see and he performs extraordinary works that others cannot imagine.

SALVATION – BEING IN THE KINGDOM OF GOD AND RECEIVING THE HOLY SPIRIT

You have heard or read my saying many times that your relationship with Jesus is just that, your relationship. It has nothing to do with any other person. Not your parents, not your priest or pastor, not your friends.

It is a one on one relationship. You and Jesus. That is such an important point to make with any of those you are helping the Father lead to Jesus.

Further, only God can draw a person to Jesus. Family, friends, acquaintances can and should as possible describe Jesus and present the gospel message to an unbeliever. But they cannot make a person believe. Only God does that.

Let's go further. When a person has that great epiphany moment when they see Jesus for who he is and ask and accept him as their Lord, they are said to be born again. Those are words Jesus used himself. At that moment they get a new spirit – the old has gone and the new has come. The disciple John describes it as God himself becoming their father.

And then if they are spiritually open to it, they can receive the Holy Spirit and even be baptized into the gifts of the Spirit such as healings, discernment, word of knowledge, prophecy and more. It is good to be around true born again, spirit-filled believers. One of them can pray for a new believer to receive the Holy Spirit and the gifts, as the disciples did in several examples in the book of Acts.

Peter said the Holy Spirit is for everyone, those near and those far away, speaking of course of believers in the Lord Jesus. The Holy Spirit does wondrous things in a person's life. Jesus said the Holy Spirit leads a person into all truth, tells of things yet to come, and reminds the person of things Jesus has said to them. He tells us things he hears (from the Father and from the Lord Jesus).
